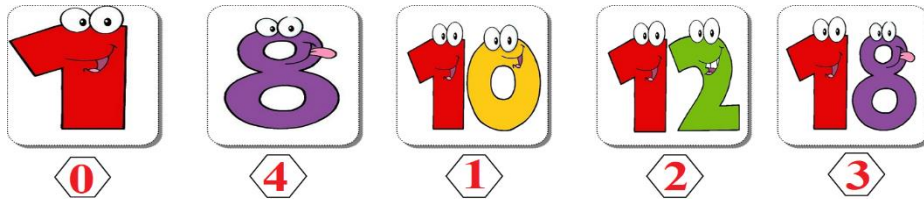


Fourteen is smaller greater than fifteen.

Nine is **smaller** than twelve.



Eleven is **greater** than ten.


2.

Twelve is **smaller** than thirteen.

Ten is **greater** than five.
